Manchester City would like to welcome Atalanta supporters to the Etihad Stadium on Tuesday 22 October, kick off 8pm.

Manchester City's <u>visiting supporter guide is available here</u>, however please note the following important information, which supersedes any information that may be in the guide.

- Supporters are advised to arrive no later than 60-minutes prior to kick off
- Bags are not allowed in to the visitor's section and storage is not available.
- There will be security and ticket checks prior to entering the stadium, which may cause a delay
- It is important you have purchased and are in possession of a valid match ticket and it is activated to allow you access into the stadium.
- Manchester City does not have a neutral area and visiting supporters must only be located in the visiting section of the stadium.
- Visiting supporters identified in the home areas of the stadium will be ejected.
- Manchester City accepts no liability for tickets purchased through unofficial channels.
- Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult (over 18) when attending a match and are advised to carry photo ID to prevent any issues entering the stadium.
- Anyone who does not have a valid ticket will not be able to enter the stadium.
- Supporters without a match ticket are advised not to visit the Etihad Campus and remain in Manchester city centre to watch the match.

MANCHESTER CITY U19 v ATALANTA U19 - UEFA YOUTH LEAGUE

This match takes place at the Academy Stadium; kick off at 3pm. Only visiting supporters in possession of a valid match ticket for the First Team game will be allowed access to the Academy Stadium for this match. Supporters wishing to attend should make their way to the Academy Stadium, where a ticket booth will be located on the City Plaza which will be open from 12pm. Upon production a First Team match ticket, you will be provided with a ticket for the Youth match. Tickets are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. There are no on the day sales for visiting supporters for this match.

VISITING SUPPORTER ACCESS

To gain access to the campus, you will need to show a valid match ticket at the campus entrance which is defined by the green perimeter fence line around the stadium. Supporters without a valid match ticket will not be allowed access to the campus. Visiting supporters are advised to enter via Gate 7, located on Ashton New Road, adjacent to the visiting supporter entrance.

Supporters will be searched prior to entering the stadium. These thorough searches will be carried out by Greater Manchester Police, Manchester City Security and search dogs will also be present. Any supporter found with weapons or pyrotechnics in their possession are liable to arrest. Amnesty bins will be located outside the visiting section.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Items that are **prohibited** to be taken in to the stadium include:

- Knives, weapons (or items considered to be weapons)
- Pyrotechnics, flares or smoke bombs
- Air horns, loud hailers (megaphones) and musical instruments
- Golf umbrellas
- Professional Cameras or Audio Recording Equipment (though mobile phones are allowed)
- Food and drink (supporters are reminded that alcohol is not served at UEFA Champions League matches)
- Cigarettes including e-cigarettes

This list is not exhaustive, and the final decision lies with the Club's stewards as to which items will be allowed in to the stadium.

FLAGS AND BANNERS

Manchester City are happy for supporters to bring flags or banners (max. 2m x 1m). Please note: flag poles are not allowed nor are flags that portray offensive language and/or imagery. Flags that are required to be fixed, are oversized or need to be attached to any part of the stadium are also not allowed. Flags are not allowed to be hung over Level 2 due to the LED boards.

CODE OF CONDUCT: RESPECT THE BADGE

If you ever witness crime, vandalism, violence, drugs, the use of smoke bombs and pyrotechnics or abusive behaviour from home or visiting supporters, inside or outside the Etihad Stadium, make contact with a steward as soon as you can and report your concerns.

AFTER THE MATCH

At the end of the match, there may be a request, in consultation with Greater Manchester Police, for visiting supporters to remain in the stadium for a short time whilst the immediate areas clear. You will be informed of this during the match via PA announcements. We will ensure that you are able to exit the stadium as soon as possible, so that you may commence your return journey.

Due to external segregation after the match, you will not be able to turn left towards the Etihad Campus Metrolink stop. You will be directed around the stadium. Both Holt Town and Velopark stops - the Metrolink stations on either side of the Etihad Campus - will not be operational for at least an hour after each the match. The consumption of alcohol is not permitted on Metrolink trams.

Manchester City is committed to be a good neighbour to the residents of East Manchester. Please respect their homes and property by carefully disposing of your rubbish, using the toilets provided on the stadium campus, adhering to the residents parking scheme that is in operation and being mindful of minimising noise and disruption when you leave.
