- **Parking area for visiting buses.**

Visiting buses are required to park on Camino de la Ermita, a road which is perpendicular to Calle Blasco Ibáñez that runs alongside the Estadio de la Cerámica.

The parking is coordinated by the Villarreal CF head of security, with the away team's head of security and the local police force.

- **Access to the stadium for away fans.**

Villarreal CF has an exclusive area of the stadium for away fans, which is the upper tier of our north stand, and has a capacity of 2,062: 1,308 seats with full

visibility and 754 with reduced visibility, the latter will only be available for purchase once the full visibility seats have been sold out and at a reduced price. The stand is very safe, as it is only occupied by away fans and has exclusive access. The entrance to the away stand is gate number 25.

- **Access to the stadium for the disabled.**

Access for the disabled is via the north stand (fondo norte), next to the Entrelíneas restaurant.

The space for disabled spectators is small and for this reason it is only offered to spectators that use wheelchairs. This area has direct access to bathrooms, health care and bars that serve drinks and cold food.

- **Location of incident report desk and fan customer service telephone nº**

5 ticket offices are available at the Estadio de la Cerámica that only open on match days, from two hours before kick off and are open until the start of the second half.

The incident report desk is the first of those, which is located near to the entrance gate to the private boxes called "Casals Grocs".

The fan customer service number is (+34) 964524000 and is operational from Monday to Saturday, 10am to 1:45pm and 5pm to 8:30pm.

- **Services inside the stadium (restaurant, bar, shop, museum, etc...)**





Inside the stadium there are two sets of mens and ladies toilets under the away stand and an area with bars that serve drinks and cold food.

Located on the corner between the Main Stand and the South Stand of the stadium is the official club shop that only offers its services to the fans on match days.

In the surroundings of the stadium fans can find several shopping centres, restaurants and cafeterias.

A future project is in place to add a museum to the stadium to improve the tour experience for visiting fans.

## **PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN VILA-REAL**

### **TRAIN**

Villarreal's train station is on the line C-6 (Cercanías Valencia Norte-Castellón). From here you can move around the town by bus or bike (Bicivila't).

As a result of the constructions on the Mediterranean coast, the number of trains stopping at Vila-real has been considerably affected.

# THE CITY



## VISIT VILA-REAL

The warmth of its citizens and its environment are some of the most charming things about this town, which allows visitors to enjoy a few days off, with a wide variety of services available. Vila-real preserves a rich architectural heritage, the remains that history has left in the city year after year.

King Jaime I gave Vila-real “la Carta Pobra” on 20th February 1274 and an annual fair -Fira de santa Caterina-, which was declared a tourist interest festivity by the regional government.

Since its foundation, apart from the renowned hipodamic grid plan, other remains are still maintained such as the arched ‘La Vila’ square, the bridge over the river Mijares and the walls that surrounded medieval Vila Real. From the walls and the four towers which defended the villa, there remains are still conserved in the Torre Motxa and one of the walls of Casa de l’Oli, where the city record office and exhibition rooms are now located.
