Fan information Leipzig, April 5th, 2022



Dear Fans of Atalanta Bergamo,

we are looking forward to welcoming you as guests of the football match of your team and the team of RB Leipzig on April, 7th 2022, in the city of Leipzig. The football stadium will open at **04:45 pm**. The match will start at **6:45 pm**.

In order to guarantee an exciting and SAVE sports event, **please pay attention to the following information:**

1) Transportation to and from the stadium:

a) To guarantee a save bus transport to and back from the stadium and due to some road construction detours, please use the following route:

BAB 9 Munich in the direction of Berlin >> Motorway junction Rippachtal exit nr. 19 on BAB 38 in the direction of Leipzig, exit nr. 31, "Leipzig-Süd" >> B2 in the direction of Leipzig >> Wundtstraße >> left Karl-Tauchnitz-Straße >> at the roundabout 3rd exit Edvard-Grieg-Allee >> Marschnerstraße > Am Sportforum>>Cottaweg (bus parking spaces are signposted on the right-hand side of the road, watch out for the Kleinmesse rescue access road/park buses in a gap to avoid oncoming traffic The exit of the fans from the buses takes place directly on the "Cottaweg" Leipzig (right-hand side!) upon arrival.

After the match, the departure starts there in the direction on motorway BAB 38/BAB 9. The bus stops are located a short walk from Red Bull Stadium and can be reached via 'Uferweg'. Please note, that the parking spaces on "Cottaweg" are for buses only! The emergency forces acting on site will enforce this if necessary.

b) For guests travelling **individually by car**, we recommend the use of the signposted **Park & Ride parking lots.** There are **no parking facilities** available near the stadium.

Please note that **the guest block** of the stadium can only be accessed from the northern direction via **'Uferweg'** (at 'Sportforum/ Landauer Brücke'). **After the match**, please follow the way back to the busses **ONLY via 'Uferweg'** to 'Landauer Brücke'/ 'Am Sportforum'.

The **meeting point** on the match day will be at **Richard-Wagner-Platz** in Leipzig. This place is centrally located and is easily accessible by public transport. A **bus transfer** from the Richard-Wagner-Platz to the stadium (exit point "Landauer Brücke/Uferweg") will be provided by Leipziger Verkehrsbetriebe.

Only showing up at the time the stadium opens guarantees that you will be in the stadium at the start of the match! Larger groups that arrive much later will probably not be able to experience the kick-off in the stadium due to the diligent controls that are required.

2) How to guarantee safety in the stadium

It is prohibited to climb over fences, barriers and block dividers. We urge you not to bring any prohibited objects into the stadium. In particular, the carrying of pyrotechnics and disguises are prohibited by law and will be consistently prosecuted. It is also prohibited to bring glass and PET bottles as well as cans and other stable beverage containers into the stadium. If you have such beverage containers with you, please hand them in at the entrance area. Fans under the influence of alcohol will not be admitted to the stadium. Persons who are subject to a stadium ban are not allowed enter the stadium. If you do not observe the ban, the club and the police will take action against you.

3) How to contact the police on 07/04/2022

To ensure your safety, the police will be present at the stadium and in the surrounding area on match day. If there are any questions or concerns in the course of your arrival and departure or in the stadium, please contact the police officers or the stewards deployed. Our aim is to ensure

the safety of everyone involved and we also hope for your support in this. Please refrain from any provocations that could lead to riots and follow the instructions of the stewards and the police. Please bear in mind that provocative actions risk not only your own safety but also that of other visitors. We are therefore compelled to resolutely and consistently prevent violent and aggressive actions and to report any offences committed without exception.

We wish you a pleasant stay in Leipzig and- despite all the sporting rivalry- an exciting and fair football match.
